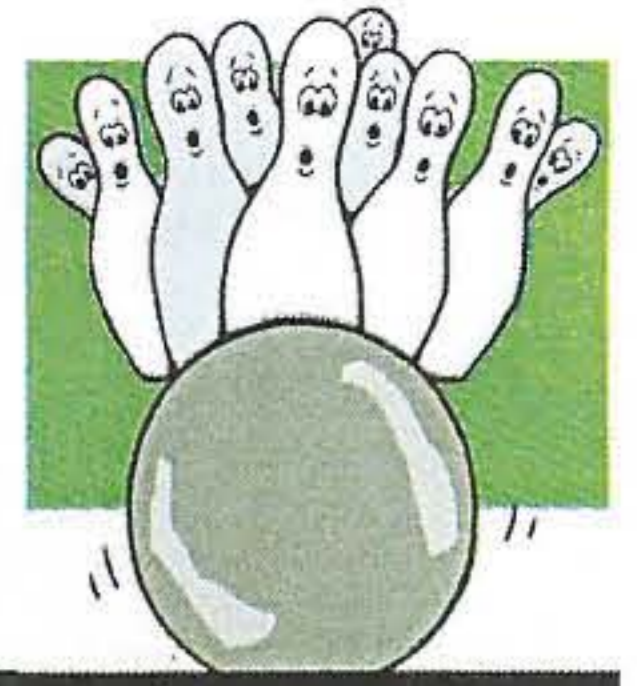

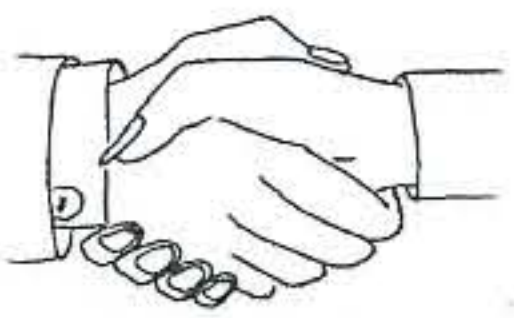


SAVE THE DATE!

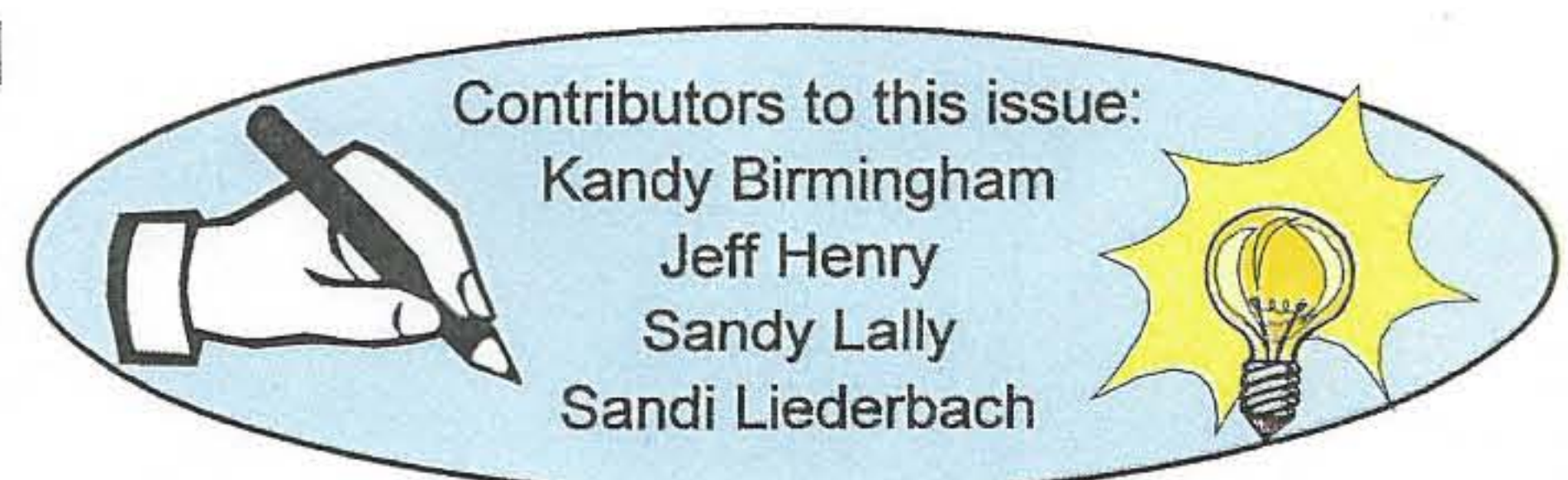
MEET OUR NEW MILWAUKEE AREA USBC BOARD MEMBERS

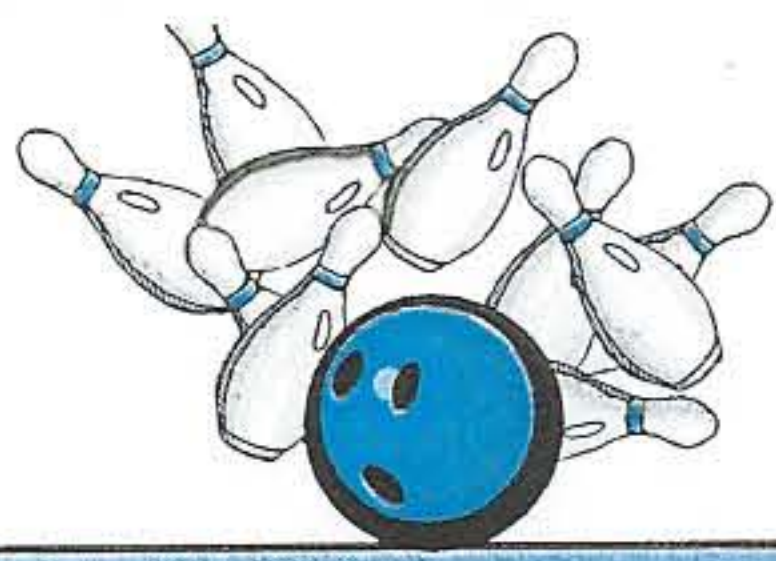

WILD MUSHROOM & SCALLOP TOASTS

12 baguette slices 1/4 inch thick
 Olive oil
 6 oz shitake mushrooms, stems discarded, roughly chopped
 1/2 tsp dried rosemary
 1/3 cup thinly sliced shallots
 1 tbsp finely chopped garlic
 3 tbsp dry white wine
 salt and pepper



4 tsp chopped flat parsley
 4 large scallops, side muscle removed, patted dry
 Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place baguette slices on foil lined baking sheet and brush each side with oil. Bake on center rack 4 minutes, then turn over for 2 more. Remove and cool.
 Saute mushrooms and shallots in oil until softened and slightly browned. Add garlic and rosemary, salt and pepper, and cook for 1 minute. Add wine and cook until liquid is gone.
 When ready to serve, top each toast with mushroom mixture and place in oven while you sear the scallops.
 To sear scallops, slice into 2 or 3 rounds, depending on the size, and pat them dry. Heat saute pan with olive oil over medium to high heat until hot. Add scallops and sear until golden - about 1 minute. Then turn and cook the other side. Do not overcrowd the scallops or they will not sear! Salt and pepper scallops.
 Top each toast with scallop and garnish with parsley.
